SPONSOR: The Two Buttons Deep Great Upstate Musicians Showcase (the "Contest") is sponsored by Two Buttons Deep LLC, 19 Dove Street, Albany, NY 12210 ("Sponsor"). The limited liability company is organized and in operation in New York State.

CONTEST PERIOD: The Contest begins at 8:00pm ET on January 13, 2021 and ends at 11:59 pm ET on January 22, 2021 (the "Entry Period"). The Sponsor is responsible for tracking receipt of entries. Entries received after the deadline will be deemed invalid. This Contest is governed exclusively by federal and state law within the United States.

PRIZE: One (1) Prize will be awarded. Winner will be selected via votes online at twobuttonsdeep.com. Winner will receive twelve (12) cases of Miller Lite beer, a cash prize of \$500, and additional prizes that may be awarded at the sole discretion of the Sponsor. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant found to be disrupting the operation of the Contest. If the integrity of the Internet portion of the Contest is compromised in any manner, Sponsor reserves the right to modify and randomly select a winner from valid entries received that are unaffected by the problem. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of any online Entrant, Entrant will be deemed the individual named first on the online entry. ONLINE OFFICIAL ENTRY: A person may enter online by completing and submitting the online entry form available on the Sponsor's homepage (www.twobuttonsdeep.com). Each online entry must include Entrant's first and last name, complete address including zip code, telephone number, email address (if applicable) and video submission. By completing the online entry form, the Sponsor is authorized to use and retain the official entry information for all Entrants. All completed online entries must be received by January 22, 2021 by 11:59 p.m. EST.
